Rabbi's Message



The festival of Shavuot is nearly upon us. Friday, May 14, the Shabbat before Shavuot, this year's Confirmands will take their places in the "chain of tradition" which reaches all the way back to the giving of the Torah at Mount Sinai. Our tenth graders have anticipated this service for many, many years. Please attend as they read the Ten Commandments from our Precious Legacy Holocaust Scroll and affirm their Jewish faith and the way of life it demands. This year, we celebrate a simcha with the families of: Kevin Adell, Samantha Basch, Gabriel Brown, Theodore Eisenberg, Samantha Madden, Jeffrey Robbins, Sarah Ungar, and Monty Weltman.

Let me ask a question: If you are (or were) married, does the remembrance of your wedding day still cause your pulse to quicken? For a moment, recall the anticipation, the joy, the depth of commitment, and the poignancy of your dearly departed friends and relatives. Marriage needs mazel (luck) and takes effort, and God willing, your efforts will bear goodly fruit.

Any idea what the Kabbalists compared to a marriage? They explained that on Shavuot, God gave us the Torah and entered into a marriage with us — and our children and our children's children — until the end of time. God made a commitment to be our God and we made a commitment that we would be His people. Our ancestors were not afraid to enter into this marriage with total trust, and without any guarantees in advance. We committed ourselves to live in a certain way until... that's right... until death do us part.

When our rabbis wanted to underscore just how binding and powerful was this commitment at Sinai, they compared it to a marriage. For to them, no commitment could be stronger. In Exodus 19:17, the Torah teaches that our ancestors "stood under the mount." My teacher, Isidore Reisman (of blessed memory), said Mount Sinai served as a chupah under which God and the Jewish people were united in an eternal marriage. (At the time of writing, I was unable to find the precise source for Mr. Reisman's teaching, however, I am still searching and learning.)

So, our tradition likened the commitment of the Jewish people to God and Torah as the commitment of husband and wife. Fast forward 3,200 years and we find many modern Jews have a commitment to Torah very much like the modern commitment to marriage. Just think if the Torah was offered to the Jewish people today! Would we proclaim: "Naaseh v'nishmah - we will do and we will listen" (Exodus 24:7), or would we give it to our lawyers to check the fine print? Perhaps we would draw up a pre-nuptial agreement? And as for the Ten Commandments...calling them the "ten suggestions" would be better. Nothing, so to speak, should be cast in stone. Sadly, that is the attitude too many Jews have these days. And then we wonder why many of our kids question: Why be Jewish?

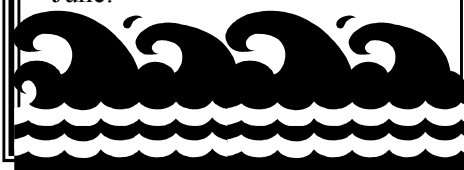
